Knowledge

What is a blanket stitch?

Why is the blanket stitch useful? (reinforces the edges of a fabric material or join two piece of fabric)

What is the benefit of a simpler design? (can be finished to a higher standard.

What is an appendage?

Why are soft toys made by creating appendages separately and then attaching them to the main body?

Why are small neat stitches which are pulled taut important when making a soft toy?

Skills

I can design a stuffed toy considering the main component shapes required and create an appropriate template to use.

I can consider the proportions of individual components.

I can create a 3D stuffed toy from a 2D design.

I can measure, mark, and cut fabric accurately and independently.

To create strong and secure blanket stitches when joining fabric, making sure the spaces between the stitches are even and regular.

To thread needles independently.

To use applique to attach pieces of fabric decoration.

To test and evaluate the finished product and give points for further improvement.
