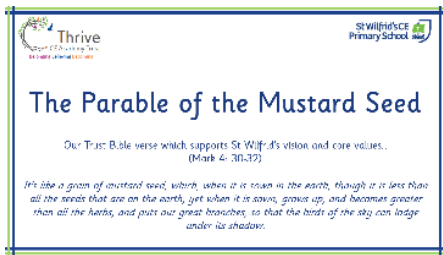




Our Trust Vision from Mark 4: 30-32 represents the journey of growth all pupils within our Trust schools will take:

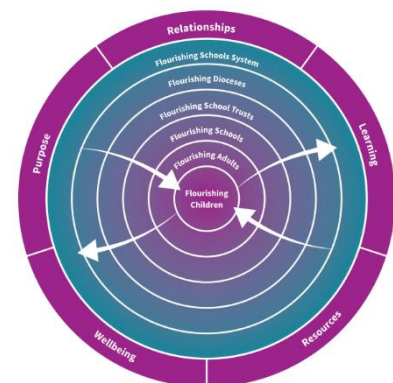
